**Agnew Tops Gallup Poll  
As Nixon Running Mate**

Vice President Agnew has a clear lead as the first choice of the nation's Republican voters to repeat as President Nixon's running mate in November, the Gallup Poll reported yesterday.

Mr. Agnew won 43 per cent of the vote among eight persons listed in the most recent poll. Following Mr. Agnew were Gov. Ronald Reagan of California, 20 per cent; Governor Rockefeller of New York, 14 per cent, and Senator Charles H. Percy of Illinois and John B. Connally, the retired Treasury Secretary, both with 8 per cent.

In a similar poll last October, Mr. Agnew led with 27 per cent, while Mr. Reagan had 19 per cent, Mr. Percy 13 per cent and Mr. Connally and Mr. Rockefeller each 10 per cent.
