

Sihanouk, Interviewed in Peking, Opposes Geneva-Style Parley
to End Indochina War

Peking, June 6 - Prince Norodom Sihanouk, the exiled Cambodian leader, said in an interview here today that he was unalterably opposed to any Geneva-type conference to end the Indochina war. [Gives reasons.]

..... The Prince said that a Geneva type of conference had been proposed by the Soviet Union along with France and Britain, but that he, North Vietnam, the Vietcong and the Pathet Lao opposed such a meeting and he had asked China to do the same.
