State Department's List
Linked to Political Mailing

WASHINGTON, Sept. 26
(UPI)—The State Department acknowledged today that it had supplied the White House with its Public Affairs Division's mailing list, which was apparently used by the Democrats for Nixon campaign organization.
The department spokesman, Charles W. Bray 3d, said that the list, of about 5,000 names, included persons who regularly received the department's press releases and foreign affairs publications.
He said that the department responded to a request from the White House "a week or two ago" and did not know what use had been made of the list. The organization apparently used it to send out attacks on the foreign policy positions of Senator George McGovern, the Democratic Presidential nominee.
