Tricia Nixon Cox, campaigning for her father and other Republicans, shook hands yesterday with blacks and whites near the bridge where civil rights demonstrators were turned back in a bloody confrontation in 1965.

After starting the day in Birmingham, the older daughter of President Nixon

was greeted by cheers of "four more years" as she helped GOP Senate candidate Winton M. (Red) Blount open the Selma Nixon-Blount campaign headquarters.

Secret Service security was tight but there was a friendly atmosphere as 1000 persons greeted Mrs. Cox in 91-degree sunshine.
