PHOENIX (Ariz.) —
(UPI) — An arson-set fire caused \$100,000 damage to Republican campaign headquarters here early today.

Campaign literature, typewriters, desks and other office equipment throughout the two-story building housing the Committee to Reelect the President were destroyed or damaged beyond use.

Bob Biven, chief investigator for the Phoenix Fire Department, said a flammable liquid was used to start the blaze in a first floor hallway about 2:30 a.m.

The flames spread quickly, gutting the lower level and causing smoke and heat damage upstairs. There were no injuries.
