A Brief Visit With Wallace

MONTGOMERY (Ala.) — (UPI) — Sen. Barry Goldwater (R-Ariz.) and Republican Senate nominee Winton M. Blount must have had a strong inkling their visit with Gov. George Wallace would be brief.

Goldwater, who swept a number of Alabama GOP candidates into office when he carried Alabama in his 1964 presidential race, visited with Wallace about 25 minutes yesterday.

But he and Blount, running for the Senate from Alabama, failed to get Wallace to change his mind and publicily support President Nixon.
