

More Press Parleys Are Planned by Nixon

WASHINGTON, Jan. 19 (UPI)—President Nixon, who has not held a news conference for almost four months, will meet more frequently with reporters during his second term, the White House press secretary, Ronald L. Ziegler, said today.

"I think you'll find as we move into the second term that the President will have frequent contact with the press, including press conferences," Mr. Ziegler said.

He said Mr. Nixon had decided that press conferences were "not in the public interest" during the Vietnam peace negotiations.

The President's last general news conference was on Oct. 5. His last public speech was on the eve of the Nov. 7 election although he spoke briefly to newsmen at Camp David on Nov. 27.
