## Kissinger Has Talks With Chou and Other Leaders in Peking

Peking, Feb. 16 (Reuters) -

Mr. Kissinger may have come with an offerfrom President Nixon to reduce the American forces in Taiwan by as much as 6,000 men, according to reports from the United States.

Likewise, the expansion of Soviet influence into Asia, the issue of American forces in South Korea and the possibility of some sort of United States diplomatic representation in Peking later this year may also have been discussed.

Diplomatic sources here said members of the American delegation concerned with the media, cultural, scientific and sports exchanges had meetings today with Chinese officials. The United States would like such exchanges to develop faster, it is believed here.
