Henry A. Kissinger conterred for four hours with Prime Minister Chou En-lai in Peking yesterday, the second day of the White House envoy's four-day mission to China.

The White House said Kissinger, in China for "concrete consultations" following the Vietnam peace settlement, has met with Chou for a total of 7½ hours.

Press Secretary Ronald Ziegler made the announcement here, reading from a brief cablegram from Kissinger.
