## SEC Probe Figure Gave GOP \$200,000

New York, Feb. 27 - Officials of President Nixon's re-election campaign last year solicited - and got - a secret \$200,000 cash contribution from the key figure [Robert L. Vesco] in a Securities and Exchange Commission investigation of an alleged multimillion dollar international swindle, according to sworn testimony filed in federal court here today.
