 formed by Judge Gerard  
 J. O'Connor, U.S. District  
 Court of Spring Valley,  
 N.Y., at the home of the

 a state developer and  
 former Scali.  
 The bride is the White  
 House press secretary  
 for the president in  
 1971. She was the  
 American Broadcasting  
 Company's diplomatic  
 correspondent.  
 Scali worked in  
 Paris and Rome for the CIA  
 and later tutored CIA per-  
 sonnel in Rome since lan-  
 guages. He was research  
 assistant on Saturday  
 evening for the  
 last five years as an assistant  
 to Hugh Downs, columnist  
 and Washington bureau  
 chief of the network.
