WASHINGTON - (U̇PI) - A new Gallup poll shows four of every 10 persons questioned believed President Nixon knew about the Watergate affair in advance.
The poll, published yesterday, also showed that about one-third of the persons interviewed felt the case revealed corruption in the White House.
A large majority of Americans - 83 percent -had read or heard about the case when the poll was taken last week, before Nixon made his announcement that there had been "major developments" in the case and that his aides would testify about it.
