Ziegler, the White House press secretary, when he flies to Paris tomorrow to resume talks Wednesday with Le Duc Tho, Hanoi's chief negotiator, on strengthening the Vietnam cease-fire agreement, the White House said today.

Mr. Ziegler's first direct involvement in the Vietnam negotiations, it came as a surprise to White House newsmen.

A White House official said President Nixon wanted Mr. Ziegler to have "a better substantive grasp" of the issues.

William H. Sullivan, Deputy Assistant Secretary for East Asia and Pacific Affairs, has been in Paris in preliminary tlks with Mr. Tho's deputy, Nguyen Co Thach. They meet today for five and a half hours.
