The Secret Service issued a bulletin to the police and all other law enforcement agencies yesterday to arrest a man accused of threatening to kill President Nixon.

A Secret Service spokesman said the man, Harold Kenneth Culp, has a history of mental illness and is known to carry a revolver.

The threat on the life of Mr. Nixon was contained in a letter received on June 6 and a warrant for Culp's arrest was issued in Miami the next day, the spokesman said.
