Nixon Aide May Quit

Clay T. Whitehead, President Nixon's communications director, who gained notoriety last year when he suggested that local stations refuse to run network news they considered unfair to the President, will soon resign, New York magazine reported Monday.

The magazine said sources close to the administration disclosed that Whitehead's resignation will end the White House's attempts "to frighten the (television) networks and independent stations" into being friendlier to the administration.
