

CHICAGO, Aug. 2 (UPI)-AFL-CIO President George Meany said today he is break-ing tradition and not inviting President Nixon to the labor federation's convention in Oc-toher. tober.

federation's convention in Oc-tober. And besides that, Meany saïd, he isn't going to invite Labor Secretary Peter Bren-nan either. Or Agriculture Secretary Earl L. Butz. In addition, Meany said that if there's a dedication cere-mony or a new addition in the AfLCIO headquarters in Washington a block away from the White House, he won't invite Mr. Nixon to that, even though President Eisen-hower attended the dedication of the original building. Meany, 78, has been increas-ingly unhappy with the admin-istration and the Watergate disclosures. But he said Mr. Nixon wouldn't get the tradi-tional labor convention invita-tion to incumbent Presidents because of what happened two

tional labor convention invita-tion to incumbent Presidents because of what happened two years ago when Mr. Nixon was invited to the last AFL-CIO convention in Miami Beach, where the 1973 session also will be held in the same hotel.
