BURGER SON'S PAY AT G.S.A. REPORTED

NORFOLK, Va., Dec. 27 (AP)
—Wade A. Burger, son of Chief
Justice of the United States
Warren E. Burger, is drawing a
government salary of \$25,863
more than seven times what he
had earned as a real estate
salesman, The Norfolk Virginian-Pilot said Thursday.

The paper said Mr. Burger
was employed by the General
Services Administration with a
title of "special assistant to the
assistant commissioner for the
office of space management."

Mr. Burger's personnel file,
parts of which the paper said
were disclosed by a G.S.A.
spokesman, reportedly show his
duties are to coordinate work
between the office of space
management and its parent
agency, the Public Building
Service.

Pete McCall, a public relations man for the General Services Administration, was quoted by the paper as saying Mr. Burger was the first person to hold the job,
Mr. Burger, 37 years old, earned an average of \$3,270 during his last three years as a salesman of houses for Crowell & Company Inc., a Northern Virginia real estate concern the paper said.
