Iran Accepts U.S. Offer of 30 Jet Fighters

Iran has reportedly accepted a United States offer to sell it 30 Grumman F-14A fighters at a total cost of \$900 million, including spare parts.

The decision by Shah Mohammed Riza Pahlevi was conveyed to American officials Wednesday, according to highly reliable aviation sources. They added that the first 24 of the swingwing Navy fighters will be delivered to the government in Teheran in 1976.
