Jill Ruckelshaus Quits

As White House Aide

WASHINGTON, March 18 (AP)—The resignation of Mrs. Jill Ruckelshaus as a special White House assistant and head of the Office of Women's Programs was announced Monday.

Mrs. Ruckelshaus, whose husband, William, was ousted last November as Deputy Attorney General with the dismissal of the special Watergate prosecutor, Archibald Cox, has been a part-time member of the White House staff for a little over a year.

Mrs. Ruckelshaus said she was resigning because she wanted to spend more time with her five children, who range in age from five to 12 years.
