

Nixon Prepares For Russian Summit Talks

Washington

Less than a week after returning from the Middle East, President Nixon made final preparations yesterday for another diplomatic journey.

Mr. Nixon has been relaxing at his rain-drenched Camp David, Md., retreat since last Thursday, a day after his return from his fence-mending Middle East peace journey.

Aides said he was doing homework for his forthcoming summit talks in Brussels and Moscow and making occasional telephone calls to Secretary of State Henry Kissinger and top level White House officials in Washington.

The President flies tomorrow to Brussels to meet with NATO heads of state and then on to Moscow Thursday for an eight-day round of summit talks with Soviet party leader Leonid I. Brezhnev.
