Nixon Chooses Sechronicle No. 2 Man for Treasury Dept.

President Nixon's selection of Stephen S. Gardner, Philadelphia banker, to be deputy Treasury secretary was announced yesterday by the White House.

Subject to Senate confirmation, Gardner, 52, will succeed William E. Simon, who moved from the No. 2 post to Treasury secretary on the resignation of George Shutz.

Gardner, a native of Wakefield, Mass., and a graduate of Harvard University, is board chairman of Girard Trust Bank, Philadelphia.
