President Nixon received a painting of Moscow by night—Mrs. Nixon was given a set of amber jewelry in a gold setting from their Russian hosts, a White House spokesman said yesterday.

Helen McCain Smith, Mrs. Nixon's press secretary, said that Soviet Communist party secretary and Mrs. Leonid Brezhnev gave the Nixons several other gifts that were representative of the different Soviet republics.

These included a lace ta-

blecloth, a vase painted with scenes of Moscow and a box encrusted with semi-precious jewels for Mrs. Nixon.

The President gave car buff Brezhnev a blue Chevrolet Monte Carlo sports car, under the auspices of General Motors. The Nixons also presented the Soviet leader and his wife a set of plates depicting scenes from Winslow Homer paintings and a silver epergne with crystal bowls.
