BURGER AGAIN BARS SESSION ON BOMBING

WASHINGTON, Aug. 13 (AP)
—Chief Justice Warren E. Burger again denied today an application to call a special term of the Supreme Court to consider the constitutionality of United States bombing of Cambodia. It was his second such action in five days.

On Thursday, Justice Burger rejected a similar application, directed by him by American Civil Liberties Union lawyers representing Representative Elizabeth Holtzman, Democrat of Brooklyn and four Air Force officers who challenged the legality of the bombing.

The next day Representative Holtzman's lawyers filed a petition for a special term addressed to each member of the court, hoping to find sufficient sentiment to call a special term. The brief order today was signed by Chief Justice Burger alone and made no mention of the associate justices.
