

Newsman Queried on Report Of Gunfire at San Jose Rally

KEY BISCAYNE, Fla., Nov. 8 —At least one reporter has been asked by the Federal Bureau of Investigation about unverified reports that a shot may have been fired during a rock-throwing demonstration against President Nixon on Oct. 29 in San Jose, Calif.

The origin of the report could not be determined. Neither the reporter who was questioned, Frank Cormier of The Associated Press, nor other newsmen who were with the President's party in San Jose could supply any evidence about gunfire.

The F.B.I.'s headquarters in Washington would say nothing except that it had been requested by the Justice Department to investigate an incident. It would not say where or when the report originated.
