

Huntley Voices Regret To Nixon Over Article

WASHINGTON, Aug. 6 (UPI)—Chet Huntley, the former newscaster, has told President Nixon he is sorry and "terribly embarrassed" about remarks attributed to him in a recent issue of Life magazine.

Mr. Huntley wrote a letter to Mr. Nixon on July 14 shortly after Life quoted the former newsman as saying of the President: "I've seen him under many conditions. The shallowness of the man overwhelms me; the fact that he is President frightens me."

The letter said:

"I want you to know that I am terribly embarrassed about some remarks attributed to me in the current issue of Life magazine. How the reporter had the audacity to make me responsible for the alleged statements is something I cannot understand.

"I just hope you know me well enough to appreciate that the statements do not sound like me and that I am more sorry about them than you will ever know."
