At Long Last, Nixon Has His Own Freeway

SACRAMENTO — (UPI)
— President Nixon got a freeway named after himself yesterday.

The Senate adopted, 30-0, an Assembly-passed resolution by Assemblyman John V. Briggs (R-Fullerton) designating a 30 mile segment of California 90 the "Richard M. Nixon Freeway."

The freeway extends from just north of the Los Angeles International Airport to the Riverside Freeway in Yorba Linda, where the President was born. It also runs through Whittier, where he was raised.

The Assembly has adopted similar measures the past two years only to have the Senate kill them each time. There was no debate this year.
