Moscow, May 28 (AP) -- Mrs. Richard M. Nixon walked through the grand halls of the Kremlin today and inspected the armory, containing treasures of the Czars, and said, "I still like our little White House."

Mrs. Nixon peered into glass cases containing some of the world's largest diamonds, rubies and emeralds. One imperial crown she saw contained 5,000 diamonds, another crown had a [garbled] containing 400 carats.
