Nixon's Pal Buying Home Near D.C.

Washington

President Nixon's good friend, C. G. (Bebe) Rebozo, has signed a contract to buy a \$125,000 home in the Bradley Hills area outside Washington in Montgomery county, Md.

It was unclear whether Rebozo plans to use the home as a residence when he is in town. One report indicated that it may be occupied by Julie Nixon Eisenhower and her husband, David, a Navy officer whose three-year tour of duty ends next September.

Mrs. Eisenhower and her mother, Pat Nixon, reportedly inspected the house before the contract between Rebozo and the sellers, Mr. and Mrs. Reese Sewell, was signed.

The three-bedroom 3½-bath brick rambler with swimming pool is located on a one-acre wooded lot in an area where homes in the \$200,000 range have been built in recent years.
