Pat's View of David as a Newsman

Lieutenant (j.g.) David Eisenhower, who said he might become a newspaperman when he gets out of the Navy, is not getting too much encouragement from his mother-in-law.

Chatting with reporters at the White House, Pat Nixon told David he would get "fired" because "he's too conservative."

Eisenhower will be discharged from the Navy today — his 25th birthday.

He has expressed an interest in taking a job in journalism or public affairs.
