**Watergate Called
'Cancer' by Julie**

WEST HARTFORD, Conn., June 15 (AP)—Julie Nixon Eisenhower said yesterday that the "whole Watergate affair is a bit like a cancer" to her father, President Nixon.

"You wish you could go into the hospital tomorrow and have it removed once and for all," she said. "But the judiciary system is slower than that. It will take time to do a very thorough job."

Mrs. Eisenhower told a commencement audience at the American School for the Deaf that her father's administration is going through "the best of times" and "the worst of times" simultaneously.
