

Nixon Gets to Watch His TV Game

Thanks to legislation he signed Friday, President Nixon took yesterday afternoon off to watch the Washington Redskins open the professional football season on television.

The President and Mrs. Nixon, daughter Julie Eisenhower and her husband David, watched the Redskins play the San Diego Chargers in the first game played since enactment of a law barring TV blackouts of home games sold out 72 hours before the kickoff.

Mr. Nixon, an avid pro football fan — especially of the Redskins — had a full diet of TV football available to him, with no fewer than four games available in this area.
