**Cox Hears Critic
Of Lawyers' Image**

NEW YORK, Dec. 21
(AP)—One of the 35
young attorneys who
heard a judge bemoan the
lowered public image of
lawyers "because of re-
cent unfortunate events"
war former President Nix-
on's son-in-law Edward
Cox.

Judge John R. Bartels
was unaware that Cox,
husband of Tricia Nixon
Cox, was among the law-
yers being admitted Fri-
day to practice before the
U.S. District Court in
Brooklyn.

Referring to the role of
lawyers in the Watergate
scandals, the judge urged
them to help change the
image of a profession that
"is no longer held in high
esteem."

Cox told reporters later
he planned to practice
civil law with the Wall
Street firm of Carvath,
Swaine and Moore.
