

JFK's Opinion of Nixon

(Story by Reuters on book to be published by Benjamin
Bradlee, title not given; book is on John Kennedy.
Excerpts from book were released yesterday.)

"Bradlee recalled that at the end of 1962, after
Mr. Nixon had been defeated in an attempt to become
governor of California, Kennedy said he thought Mr. Nixon
was unsound mentally, or, as he once said of him,
'sick, sick, sick.'

"Referring to Mr. Nixon's remark to reporters after
his defeat that 'You won't have Nixon to kick around any
more,' Kennedy said, 'nobody could talk like that and be
normal.'"
