Under the Freedom of Information Act, Alger Hiss filed suit yesterday to compel the Department of Justice, the Federal Bureau of Investigation, Central Intelligence Agency and other government agencies to turn over additional records and documents relating to his conviction for perjury. Material released previously by the F.B.I. produced a difference of opinion as to whether the agency originally had covered up evidence helpful to Mr. Hiss, including the manufacture date of the Woodstock typewriter considered central to the case.
