Cong Says U.S. To Use A-Arms

PARIS — (UPI) — The Viet Cong charged at the Vietnam peace talks today that the U.S. military has herded one million South Vietnamese into concentration camps in order to clear a zone for the use of tactical nuclear weapons.

The United States and South Vietnam delegates promptly labeled the charge "absurd."

Le Vah Sau, the Viet Cong press spokesman, told a news conference after the 140th session that "the Amer-

icans are accelerating in February their plans of some months to deport one million South Vietnamese to create a free-fire zone for the use of tactical atomic weapons."

A press spokesman for the South Vietnamese delegation told reporters after the session ended in the usual deadlock that only 50,000 South Vietnamese were being moved south from five provinces because their lands were affected by floods.

He said the move was "entirely voluntary."
