MORE 'NUKES' According to James R. Schlesinger, chairman of the Atomic Energy Commission, the U.S. is now producing nuclear weapons at a rate six to seven times greater than when Richard Nixon took office in 1969. The "Nukes" are going into our Minutemen 3 and Poseidon strategic missiles.

Schlesinger also points out, however, that the Soviets can develop their own MIRV system within three to five years, and since they have heavier launching capacities than we, they can easily balance or surpass us in potential nuclear destruction.
