C.I.A. SAYS ENEMY SPIES HOLD VITAL POSTS IN SAIGON

Washington, Oct. 18 - The [CIA] has told President Nixon that the Vietnamese Communists have infiltrated more than 30,000 agents into the South Vietnamese Government in an apparatus that has been virtually impossible to destroy.

Because of this, the C.I.A. reported, as United States troop withdrawals proceed, a resurgence of Communist strength in South Vietnam can be expected.
