Red China Condemns U.S. Raids

TOKYO — (AP) — Communist China again today condemned U.S. air strikes against North Vietnam and said Peking is keeping an eye on developments in Indochina.

Pravda, the Soviet Communist Party newspaper, declared in Moscow that the bombings constitute "an old policy of continuing and widening aggression" that is "a strategy of impotence and despair."

All major Soviet newspapers printed a statement from Tass, the news agency, denouncing the raids as renewed aggression and provocation.

Peking and Moscow began a chain of bitter criticisms of the United States soon after the strikes were announced.

Peking's foreign ministry assured North Vietnam the Chinese "are determined to stand forever with the fraternal peoples of Vietnam and the other Indochinese countries and unite and fight together with them till complete victory."
