

Hanoi Asserts It Is Ready For Renewed U.S. Bombing

PARIS, Dec. 13 (Reuters)—Hanoi's chief negotiator at the peace talks here, said tonight his country was prepared for a possible resumption of the bombing of North Vietnam.

"We are ready" Xuan Thuy told newsmen in an allusion to President Nixon's warning Thursday that he would order the bombing of military sites and supply lines in the North if a Hanoi military build up threatened the withdrawal of United States troops from the South.

Mr. Thuy declined to say what Hanoi's reaction would be.

"If the United States continues the war," he said, "we must continue to fight. If the U.S. intensifies the war, we must face this intensification. But we are certain that violence can never defeat a just cause."
