

Hanoi Says Prisoner Mail Was Given to U.S. Visitors

TOKYO, Dec. 25 (UPI)—The Hanoi radio said today that an American delegation had been given 319 letters and 330 Christmas cards for the families of United States prisoners of war in North Vietnam.

The broadcast, heard in Tokyo, said that the three-member delegation received the letters and cards yesterday from North Vietnam's "American Peoples Solidarity Committee."

The three—Donald Young, Miss T. Young and Anne Barnett arrived in Hanoi with Christmas presents and letters for the prisoners, the broadcast said.
