

THREE DEAD PILOTS IDENTIFIED

Paris, Jan. 7 (Reuters) - The Hanoi delegation to the peace talks today identified three United States pilots killed when their planes either had been shot down or crashed in North Vietnam.

The pilots were identified as Donald Maurice Singer, Arthur Steward Mearns and Capt. Samuel Fantle 3d. No home towns were given.

The first two names were also given to the New York-based Committee for Liaison With American Families, Mr. Le said. Mr. Fantle's name was given to Senator George McGovern, Democrat of South Dakota, in response to a query, he added.
