There is NOTHING POLITICAL about the Geneva Conventions regarding treatment of Prisoners of War. They speak only of basic civilized behavior. The treatment of POWs is a humanitarian question-nothing more!

But, ambitious politicians both in and out of Congress are trying to use the POW issue to support their demand for a withdrawal date for all American troops in Vietnam. They have every right to work for their solutions to the war, but they must not be allowed to bring the POWs and MIAs into the political arena. At a meeting of the POW-MIA, International at Los Alamitos Naval Air Station May 16, 1971, one of these ambitious politicians—a California Congressman, urged a withdrawal date as the best way to get the POWs back and stated that he had funds available to fly family members back to Washington to help in this effort.
