U.S. Refuses To Talk

Paris

The United States and South Vietnam yesterday confirmed their refusal to hold a formal Vietnam peace talk session this week and gave no indication when they would resume the stalemated negotiations with North Vietnam and the National Liberation Front.

Under conference rules all participants must agree on a date for new meetings. Given as justification for the cancellation of the regular Thursday meeting were "recent propaganda activities incompatible with negotiation," a reference to an international anti-war congress in Versailles.
