

Hangchow Likely Place For Nixon-Mao Meeting

Honolulu (AP) - Secretary of State William P. Rogers, who was with [the nixons] aboard the presidential plane, said in response to newsmen's questions that the U.S. government has no confirmation of a report that Le Duc Tho, the Hanoi official who conducted secret negotiations with presidential adviser Henry A. Kissinger, would arrive in Peking a day before Nixon.

Rogers offered no support for speculation that the North Vietnamese official would be meeting with Nixon or other Americans in Peking.
