Paris Talks Postponed 2nd Week

PARIS — (UPI) — The Vietnam peace talks, which have seen only 17 minutes of negotiation in the past month, have been postponed for the second consecutive week yesterday by the U.S. and South Vietnamese delegations.

A joint statement yester-day said tomorrow's session will be postponed until March 16 because of the walkout staged by the Communist delegations at the last session Feb. 24 and "recent official announcements from Hanoi:"

The Viet Cong and Hanoi delegations called the boycott absurd and said it demonstrated the hypocrisy of President Nixon They said they would announce later whether they would go along with the March 16 date.
