March for POWs

Four foot sore teen-agers arrived in Union Square yesterday after a two-day hike from Sacramento on behalf of American prisoners of war in Vietnam.

The boys are seeking contributions to pay the expenses of sending a delegate to Moscow. The delegate would try to persuade the Russians to use their influence in Hanoi to gain more hu-

mane treatment of POWs and men missing in action.

Seven boys from the Sacramento area began the 80-mile hike Saturday morning, and four finished, said Paul Eustis, 15, the red-haired leader.

Others who walked were Greg Innes, 14, McCoy Kichar, 16, and Jerome Leberry, 17.
