

Hanoi Bids U.S. Return To Paris Peace Talks

HONG KONG, Wednesday, March 29 (Reuters) — North Vietnam has called on the United States to return to the Paris peace conference on Vietnam, suspended indefinitely by President Nixon, according to the official North Vietnamese press agency.

The North Vietnamese Foreign Ministry in a statement yesterday, distributed by the agency today, said the United States must attend the conference regularly and negotiate the Vietnam issue seriously.

Referring to the United States boycott, the statement said:

"This is an extremely serious sabotage of the Paris conference on Vietnam, a new step taken by the United States Government to wreck the negotiations on the Vietnam issue."
