### 'Concord'--

## Viet Cong

PARIS — (AP) — Mrs. Nguyen Thi Binh said today that the over-all objective of the offensive in South Vietnam is the establishment of a government of "national concord" in Saigon.

Mrs. Binh, head of the Viet Cong delegation to the Paris peace talks and foreign minister of its provisional revolutionary government, told a news conference that the Viet Cong had already established its government headquarters in a "liberated zone" of South Vietnam — a claim she has made many times.

Mrs. Binh said "our aim is to liberate all of South Vietnam and to establish a government of national concord with its seat at Saigon."

She said that the Viet Cong hoped to set up the government of national concord through the peace talks here, but since the United States indefinitely suspended the talks March 23 the "national liberation forces of South Vietnam" were obliged to increase military activity.

A government of national concord is provided for under the Viet Cong's seven-point peace plan submitted last July 1. The government, which the Viet Cong says would be representative of Communist and non-Communist political forces, would come following the withdrawal of U.S. forces and the departure of President Nguyen Van Thieu.

Mrs. Binh claimed that "South Vietnamese liberation forces" had scored major victories in the two northern provinces and she said that in the north, center and south of the country hundreds of thousands of people were "rising against the repressive regime of Saigon."
