

Chou Urges U.S. To Resume Talks

Chinese Prime Minister Chou En-lai yesterday urged the United States to "resume negotiations in Paris" with North Vietnamese and Viet Cong representatives.

Although Chou criticized the United States for stepped up air and naval attacks, including the bombing of Hanoi and Haiphong, diplomatic analysts in Hong Kong considered his remarks relatively mild.

"If the U.S. government really wants to solve the Vietnam question, it must stop escalating the war and pushing the 'Vietnamization' policy, and resume negotiations in Paris and seriously consider and actively respond to the seven-point peace proposal put forward by the provisional revolutionary government of the Republic of South Vietnam."
