President Summons Rogers Home For a Meeting Today on Vietnam by Tad Szulc

Washington, May 7 - The Administration made it clear last week that it no longer considered itself under political restraint not to attack the Hanoi and Haiphong areas, in the light of the collapse of the latest round of the Vietnam peace talks in Paris.

The Hanoi and Haiphong areas were raided on April 15 and 16, but after Mr. Kissinger undertook his secret trip to Moscow later that week [20 to 24 Apr]. the United States refrained from bombing the areas. Mr. Kissinger tan secretly went to Paris last Tuesday to confer with Le Duc Tho, a member of the Hanoi Politburo, but the talks failed.
